Please remember that as Tenant(s), you are required at the end of your tenancy, to return the unit vacant with all items removed. Failure to comply will result in Community Housing removing, discarding and invoicing you for these services. We sincerely hope that this will not be the case and that you will use the following resources to assist you with your move-out.

Disposing of Old Appliances (eg. stove, fridge, freezer, washer, dryer, dishwasher, computers)
